Lee Williams III was born June 16, 1943 to the union of the late Lee Williams Jr. and Dorothy Evans Williams

He was educated in the Natchez Adams County Public School System and in New Orleans, La. He worked at The Sanitary Mattress Co. from 1962 until departing for the US Army in 1966. Upon returning from the military duties, he was employed with Goodwill Industries and Sears as a truck driver. He also worked as a taxicab driver with Elk Morrison Taxi Co. for numerous years in New Orleans.

Lee accepted Christ and was baptized under the leadership of the late Rev. Harry Grover of the Tate Magnolia B. C. on August 25, 1989.
